KIRKMONT CAMPERS NEED YOUR HELP FOR PYC!

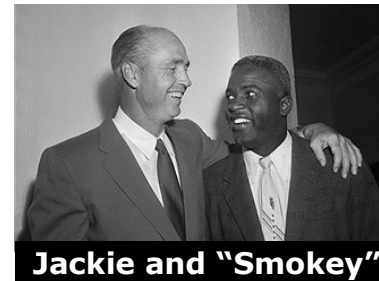

If you are able, we encourage you to bring a favorite side dish or dessert to share.

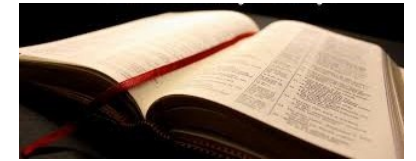


The Deacon's Children's Food Drive
